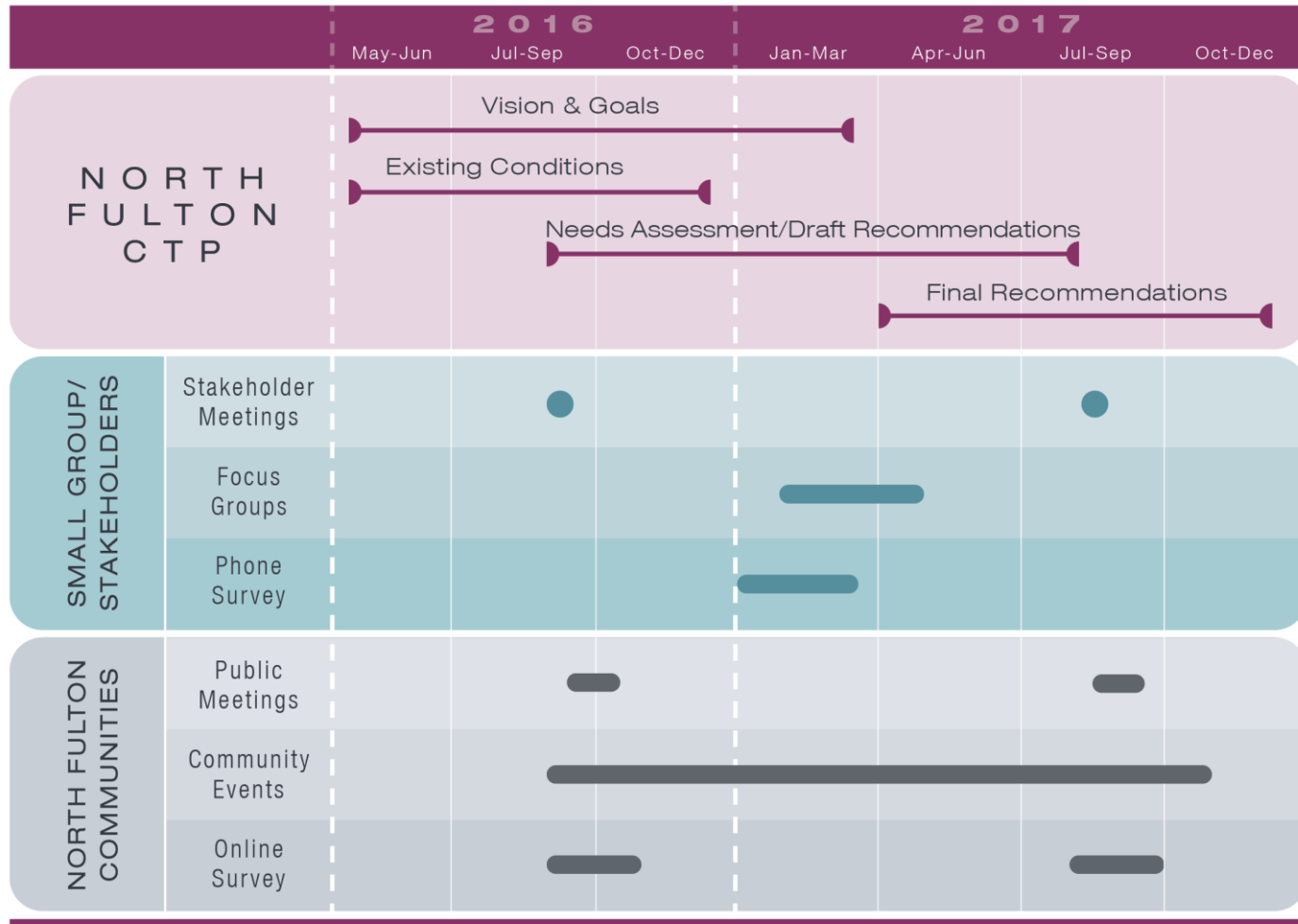


THE TWO PLANS...

Promote a safe and secure transportation system by reducing crashes, making travel predictable, and improving emergency response.

Extend the life of the transportation system by emphasizing maintenance and long-term viability.



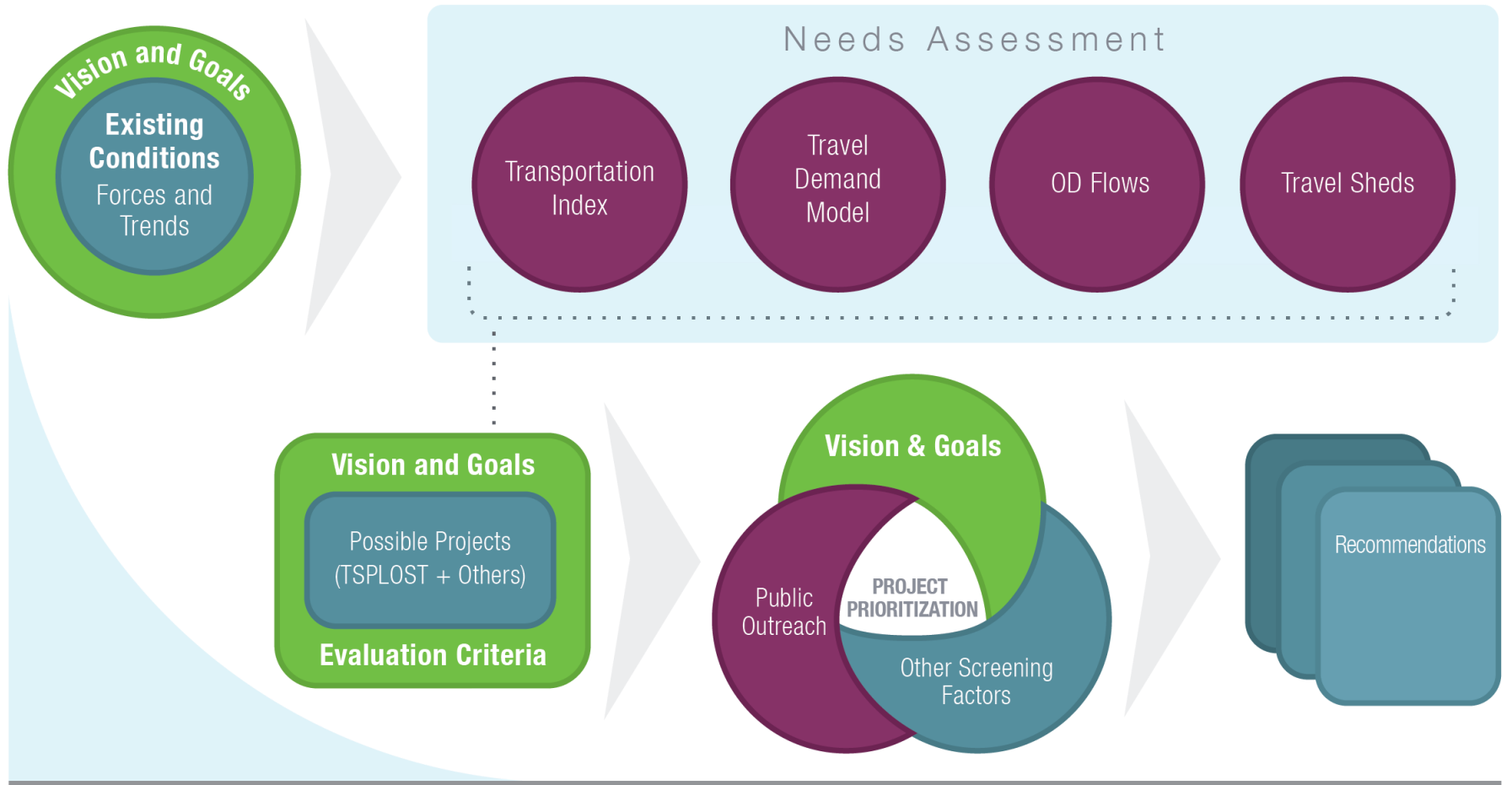

PROJECTS UNDER CONSIDERATION

- Universe of Projects
 - Previously developed projects
 - Needs Assessment
 - Stakeholder and public outreach
 - City and CID recommendations
- Evaluation of Projects
 - Based on Vision & Goals
 - Federal, State, Regional priorities
- Projects in Consideration today – all financially constrained projects except those that are already programmed and/or have funding



FUNDING LEVELS

- Project prioritization
- Reasonable assumption of future revenues through year 2040
- 3 Levels
- Equivalent to three iterations of current TSPLOST in North Fulton

<p>Big Creek Connection to Marconi This project connects to Big Creek Greenway over GA 400 through Webb Road, Windward Parkway, and Marconi Drive.</p>		
<p>Deerfield Loop Trail This project serves as a connection to the Big Creek Greenway traversing Cogburn Rd, Deerfield Pkwy, and Morris Rd.</p>		
<p>Crabapple Loop Trail This project installs a new trail on Crabapple Loop Trail from Arnold Mill Road to Birmingham Highway.</p>		
<p>Cauley Creek Trail This project is a multi-use trail that runs along Cauley Creek from the Gwinnett County line to Tech Parkway in Johns Creek.</p>
